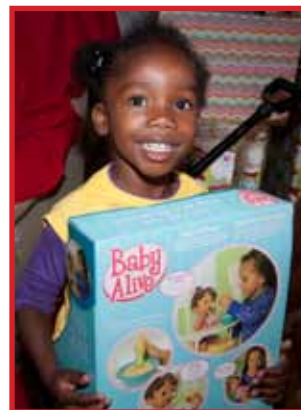

This event, chaired by Catherine and Andres Fanjul, has helped to maintain services we provide to children and families in our own community for 18 years.

New Hope Charities selected by the Palm Beach County Board of Education to participate in the Afterschool Literacy Enhancement Initiative (ALIE)

As part of a county-wide effort to address the literacy needs of children enrolled in Palm Beach County schools, the Board of Education implemented a pilot program called ALIE. The ALIE program focuses on school based after-school programs. New Hope Charities was the only non-board of education program selected for participation in this project.

As part of the ALIE program our students participate in daily activities designed to strengthen their literacy and language skills. The program is administered by a certified teacher who provides supervision and technical assistance to our counselors. Initial indicators are very promising as many of our students have improved their reading grades at school.

Nora, "Love is like, when you really love something."



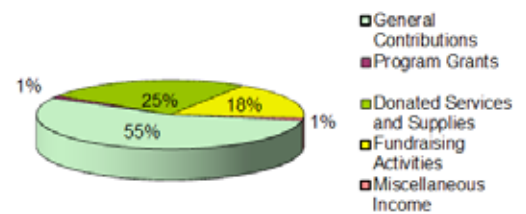

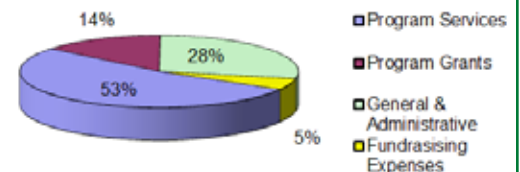

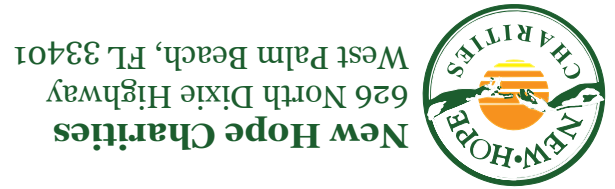
